



# UNIVERSITY PREP SCIENCE & MATH HIGH SCHOOL

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## School Uniform Policy

**All students are expected to exemplify proper grooming standards in a manner that projects an appropriate image for the student, the family, University Prep Science & Math High School, UPSM District and the greater community.**

### Slacks and Pants:

Color: Khaki or navy blue. Solid colors only.

Style: Slacks and pants can be pleated or flat front, full length.

Note: All slacks and pants must be appropriately fastened at the waist. "Sagging" will not be permitted.

### Shirts and Tops:

Color: White. Solid color only.

Style: Shirts and blouses must have button down or straight collars. Long or short sleeves with a collar required.

Note: White turtlenecks are permitted underneath the uniform shirt. All tops must be worn tucked inside pants, slacks or skirts. Manufacture trademarks/logos, if any, must be one inch or less. UPSM school logos are permitted and are not limited in size.

### Skirts and Jumpers/Skorts

Color: Khaki or navy blue. Solid colors only.

Style: Hems must extend to within three inches of the knee.

### Blazers, Cardigans, Sweaters, and Vests:

Color: Navy blue. Solid color only.

Note: All must be worn over a white collared shirt.

### Footwear

Color: Black, Brown, or Neutral.

Style: Dress shoes.

Note: Athletic shoes and any type of footwear that could constitute a safety hazard (mules, slippers, sandals, flip-flops, etc.) are not permitted.

### Neckwear and Ties

Color: Any. Students may don neck wear in the color of their choosing.

Style: Standard neck ties, bow ties, ascots, scarves and bolo string ties are acceptable.

Note: All students are required to wear a tie each day. Standard neck ties, bow ties, ascots, scarves and bolo string ties are acceptable. Logos: Manufacture trademarks, if any, must be solitary and one inch or less in size. UPSM school logos are permitted and are not limited in size or number. Inappropriate imagery of any sort will not be permitted.

### Jewelry

We ask that students refrain completely from wearing expensive jewelry to school. We do, however, recommend that each student wear an inexpensive wrist watch to support our habits of work initiatives. Modest items of spiritual or sentimental value can be worn underneath the clothing.
